

OUR ACCOMPLISHMENTS SO FAR

Positive Developments Already Produced by Our Fight Against This Bridge Route.

- Because citizens spoke out, Collin County can no longer claim that the Lavon Lake Bridge Study is a "very popular" plan.
- Our outcry caused Collin County to hold Public Meetings on the Lavon Lake Bridge Study, something they originally had not planned to do.
- If we had not gotten involved, the study would have been pushed through and completed without citizen knowledge, just like the \$500,000 bridge study money in the 2007 Bond Package vote.
- The public outcry brought focus to Hwy 78 and the other southeast Collin County road problems. Mr. Delgado can no longer claim that they NEVER hear complaints about Hwy 78.
- We brought focus on the closed Lavon Lake Dam road. Sadly the discussion returned the news that the dam road must remain closed, but the Lavon Lake Corps manager said that they will work with the police for opening the road during emergencies.
- The bridge study went from being an obscure line item in the 2007 bond package to a pivotal election issue that helped unseat our 30 year Precinct 2 Commissioner, and we are NOT done.
- We have gained support from voters all around Lavon Lake and beyond. We will continue spreading the word to the rest of Collin County. It has been our experience that all we need to do is inform the voters; the route is such a poor idea, it defeats itself.
